Decrease youth behavior, empower parent to address difficulties in raising children in adolescents.

Encouraging positive and nurturing relationships between parents/caregivers and children. Increasing children’s felt safety and self-esteem. Providing life coaching to the parent/caregiver while actively playing with their child.
