

Federal Stimulus Funding

The following table shows the SRS State General Fund savings associated with the increased federal Medicaid funding in the federal stimulus bill as reflected in Governor's Budget Amendment (GBA) #1. Over nine quarters, October 1, 2008 to December 31, 2010, the federal share of Medicaid will increase by 6.2 percent. Kansas must maintain current eligibility standards to receive the funding but the new funding directly offsets planned State General Fund appropriations.
