ONE-TIME PAYMENT FOR YOUTH

APPLY ONLINE NOW!



Youth ages **18-20** who have experienced out-of-home placement after age 14 may be eligible for a one-time pandemic relief payment.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Experienced out-of-home placement at or after age 14 in the custody of Child Welfare, Juvenile Justice, or Tribal Authority
- Current resident of Kansas
- Age **18 or older**, no longer in custody, and **under the age of 21** at the time of applying for the Pandemic Relief Payment
- Young adults who previously received a Pandemic Relief Payment are not eligible

Applications Open: Oct. 1, 2021 - Aug. 31, 2022

Additional Information:

- You will need State-issued ID, birth certificate, or social security card
- You can fill out the application online or you can download a paper copy
