For each family referred to Family Preservation, the contractor receives a case rate to be paid as described below. The case rate is the total payment per family.

- A) One-third of the case rate will be paid upon referral.
- B) One-third of the case rate will be earned and payable on the 45<sup>th</sup> day after referral.
- C) The final one-third of the case rate will be earned and payable on the 90<sup>th</sup> day after referral.

The following payment exceptions apply.

A) No payment will be made when the referral for contract management responsibility is retracted, i.e., referral is withdrawn by SRS.

B) Engagement is established when the case plan is signed by the family. In some circumstances, families referred by SRS to the contractor will not become engaged in Family Preservation services. In these cases, the second and third payments will not be made.

C) For cases in which one or more children in the family being served are removed from the home for Foster Care/Reintegration services, payments will be made with the following limitations. If a child or children are removed from the home on or prior to the 45<sup>th</sup> day after referral, the second and third payments will not be made. If the removal occurs after the 45<sup>th</sup> day, but on or prior to the 90<sup>th</sup> day, the third payment will not be made.
