The definition of children "served year to date" is the number of children in OOH on the last day of the previous year plus (+) all new referrals to OOH in a state fiscal year</p> <p>Example:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. July 2005 - # of children victims by foster parent or facility employee = 3.</li> <li>2. July 2005 - # of children served year to date was 1050 ( 1000 open on June 30<sup>th</sup>. 2005 + 50 new referrals in July 2005).</li> <li>3. <p>In a reporting Month</p> <p>The number of children whose Out Of Home (OOH) placement <u>and adoption services</u> ended 12 months ago for reason of adoption finalization and have not experienced a substantiated incident of maltreatment between date that OOH ended and 365 days past the date OOH ended.</p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>divided by</b></p> <p>The total number of children whose OOH placement <u>and adoption services</u> ended 12 months ago for reason of adoption.</p> <p>Example: Reporting Month July 2006  # children in July 2005 who ended OOH for reintegration, adoption, or guardianship = 100.  # children who ended OOH in July 2005 for reintegration, adoption, or guardianship and had a substantiated victim finding between their date of discharge from custody and 365 days after discharge from custody = 2. In a Reporting Month: The # of children released from custody for reason of adoption [served by the adoption contract] within 24 months of the date of removal into care <b>divided by</b> The # of children [served by the adoption contract] released from custody for reason of adoption  Example: Reporting Month July 2005 Number of children released from custody for reason of adoption and whose discharge date was within 24 months of removal into care = 25 Number of children released from custody for reason of adoption = 100 Performance with Timely Adoption is 25% [n=25/100]
