

KIDS has the capacity to record more than one allegation or presenting situation for each assigned CINC report. The presenting situations listed above may not reflect all risk factors associated with a family. The above table reflects the maltreatment types or non abuse neglect reasons associated with family who receives family preservation as an initial service action during the fiscal year. Remaining reasons collapsed into the "Other" category includes overwhelmed parent ,Caregiver unable/refuses treatment for
