Child Abuse/Neglect reports assigned in SFY2013 have increased 5.5% compared to SFY2012.

Statewide performance of Safety of Children in Out of Home Placement continues to exceed performance standards.

95.5% of children in out of home placement are in a family like setting exceeding the state performance standard.

99.83% of children remain safe in out of home placement and 92.0% of children released of custody for reunification do not re-enter out of home care in less than 12 months, both exceeding state standards.
