Child Abuse/Neglect reports assigned in SFY2014 Jul-Mar have decreased 0.5% compared to the same time period for SFY2013.

95.5% of children in out of home placement are in a family like setting exceeding the state performance standard.

99.78% of children remain safe in out of home placement and 90.9% of children released of custody for reunification do not re-enter out of home care in less than 12 months, both exceeding state standards.
