

A CPS intake is assigned for reasons of either alleged abuse/neglect or non abuse neglect. The data source of information in this table is KIDS (Kansas Initiative for Decision Support). KIDS has the capacity to record more than one allegation or presenting situation for each assigned CPS intake. The presenting situations listed above may not reflect all risk factors associated with a family. The above table reflects the maltreatment types or non abuse neglect reasons associated with family who receives family services as an initial service action during the fiscal year. Remaining reasons collapsed into the "Other" category includes overwhelmed parent ,Caregiver unable/refuses treatment for child, etc. (non abuse/ neglect categories).
