Kansas AFDC Need Standards Effective July 16, 1996

The eligibility specialist must determine if the child's removal home was a Non-Shared Living environment or a Shared Living environment and the county level where the removal home was located. The county levels are on page 2.

Non-Shared Living:

there are **no** other adults residing in the child's removal home other than the adult(s) in the AFDC Group.

Shared Living:

there are additional adult(s) residing in the child's removal home other than adult(s) in the AFDC Group.

Note:

Households with adult SSI recipients not included in the AFDC group use shared living if the SSI payment is the full amount; if less than the full amount use non-shared.

The charts below include the allowable income limits for the Child's AFDC group to meet the two step process of determining the 185% and 100% of the AFDC Needs Standard Income tests. If the child's AFDC group's total countable income exceeds the allowable limits then child does not meet the applicable 185% or 100% AFDC Needs Standard Income test.
