- the report of abuse or neglect is unsubstantiated
- **OR** the report of abuse or neglect is substantiated and the perpetrator access to the child is **highly improbable**.

It is the expectation that all risk factors are considered (as stated in the full Risk Assessment Form), however, completion of the full Risk Assessment is not required.
