

Deeming Stepparent Income

If a stepparent lives in a parental removal home, the worker has two options. Deem the stepparents gross income where a portion of the stepparent's income is deemed towards the child removed from the home.

Option One:

Deeming means determining the amount of the stepparent's income to be included in the total gross income available to the child

Option Two:

Include the stepparent and any stepchildren residing in the removal home at the time the child was removed in the AFDC group, and include their full countable income and resources. Use option (2) when the stepparent has little or no income.

Determine the AFDC group size for the stepparent: The AFDC group size for the stepparent consists of the stepparent and any of the stepparents birth or adoptive children who is a minor living in the home, or out of the home, who are not children (birth or adoptive) of the other spouse in the household. The stepparent is not counted in the AFDC group size for the child removed from the home but the income of the stepparent is deemed to the child.
