1. Does DCF anticipate supporting the services initiated by this grant after the end of the contract period? If so, through what funding source does DCF anticipate sustaining these services?

It is DCF's contention to continue funding for this grant ongoing. Funding is approved for the SFY23 and 24; however, funding beyond June 30, 2023, will need to be reassessed and approved by leadership.

2. Does DCF have data showing the number of adoption disruptions/dissolutions that occur in Kansas in recent years (2017-2021)

3. Are there regions of KS where adoption disruption/dissolution occur at a higher rate relative to the other regions or the statewide average?

From the data gathered, Wichita appears to be the region with the most disruptions/dissolutions.

Finalized Adoptions SFY2003 through SFY2021 with Removal into Care Subsequent to their Finalization Date

Of the 14,109 finalized adoptions between 2003 and 2021, 8.3% (n=1170) have experienced subsequent re-entry into foster care. Of those families with a re-entry, the majority (80.9%) occurred two years or more after the finalized adoption.
