

nsas Supplemental P-EBT

Due to COVID-19, DCF is providing a one-time Supplemental Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) payment of \$391 per eligible child.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All school-aged students who were eligible to receive free or reducedprice meals through the National School Lunch Program or children under age 6 who received Food Assistance in June, July, or August 2022 are eligible for a one-time Supplemental P-EBT benefit covering the summer months of June, July, and August 2022.

Did Not Receive School P-EBT

Students did not receive school P-EBT even though they qualified for free or reduced-price meals because all Kansas schools had in-person learning during the 2021-2022 school year. If you do not already have a Kansas Benefits Card, you will receive one in the mail with the Supplemental P-EBT benefits on it.

Benefits will be issued Dec. 12-21, 2022.

Received Child Care P-EBT

Children who received Child Care P-EBT benefits for the 2021-2022 school year will receive their Supplemental P-EBT benefit on the same Kansas Benefits Card where their Child Care P-EBT benefits were issued.

If your child(ren) is/are eligible for the Supplemental P-EBT benefits and do not receive benefits by Dec. 31, 2022, you can apply on their behalf through the Self Service Portal from Jan. 1, 2023 through Jan. 31, 2023.
