- Potentially libelous comments
- Content that holds the State of Kansas, its agencies, officers, employees, or public officials in false light
- Content that promotes or campaigns for an elected official or a candidate running for office
- Obscene or explicit comments
- Hateful or mean-spirited comments
- Personal attacks, insults or threatening language
- Plagiarized material or intellectual property rights violations
- Private, personal information published without consent
- Commercial promotions or spam
- Comments or links to materials that are off-topic
- Comments that embed images or material from external sources
