You are an adult and have a physical, intellectual or mental disability that creates a barrier in reaching your employment goals.



You need reasonable accommodations to be able to return to work.



You need training or education to obtain or maximize your employment and your disability creates barriers.

Kansas Child Support Services (CSS) is a full-service program that offers **all services at no cost to families regardless of income.**

If this applies to you...

-  You need help getting child support or need a current child support order enforced.
-  You need help identifying the child's father or locating the child's other parent.
-  You owe child support to the State of Kansas and need help paying it back.
-  You have questions about your existing child support case.
