Thieves are stealing SNAP Food Assistance, TANF Cash Assistance and other benefits from EBT cards with skimming devices, scam phone calls and fraudulent texts.

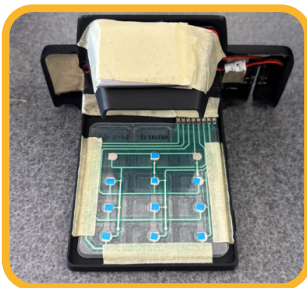
If your benefits are stolen, they CANNOT be replaced.

Before swiping your card, look for a skimming device.

Use security features on the ebtEDGE app or web portal.

Keep your card frozen and out-of-state and online purchase options off, when not making a purchase. Change your PIN monthly for extra protection.

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Never share your card number or PIN with anyone.
